Mary Lou Kalla Foundation organizes medical camp at St. Paul's School in Dinajpur, Bangladesh

Mary Lou Kalla Foundation (MLKF) organized a medical camp for mothers and children and partnered with Kellabari Mission Medical Health Services on October 25, 2014 at St. Paul's School in Dinajpur, Bangladesh. A team of ten medical professionals and staff under Dr. Toru Martina Rozario saw 285 patients (167 children and 118 mothers) during the day. Mr. Jude V. Gomez, President, Mr. Willie Gomes, Secretary of MLKF and Mrs. Cecelia Provati Rozario, Registered Nurse from The USA travelled to Bangladesh for the medical camp. Free medicines were given to the patients. St. Paul's School currently has 105 students from Kindergarten to Grade 5 and has 2 teachers. The school is partially supported financially by MLKF.
